**Title:** Fire and Police Employees' Retirement System - Benefits - Post-Retirement Increases

FOR the purpose of amending provisions of the Fire and Police Employees' Retirement System law pertaining to the method for determining annual post-retirement increases; modifying certain System interest rate assumptions; discontinuing the current variable method for determining those increases and establishing a guaranteed fixed annual increase to be paid to System retirees and beneficiaries; discontinuing the utilization of certain existing System accounting reserves; clarifying, correcting, and conforming related provisions; providing for a special effective date; and generally relating to the Fire

and Police Employees' Retirement System of the City of Baltimore.
