AN ORDINANCE concerning

Baltimore City Landmark List - Eastern Avenue Pumping Station

FOR the purpose of designating the Eastern Avenue Pumping Station, 751 Eastern Avenue, as a historical landmark.

BY adding

Article 6 - Historical and Architectural Preservation

Section(s) 13-36

Baltimore City Code

(Edition 2000)

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Baltimore City Code

Article 6. Historical and Architectural Preservation

Subtitle 13. Landmark List - 2010s

◆ 13-36. EASTERN AVENUE PUMPING STATION.

EASTERN AVENUE PUMPING STATION, 751 EASTERN AVENUE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date it is enacted.
