### **Environmental Control Board - Board Composition**

For the purpose of changing the composition of the Environmental Control Board; and generally relating to the Environmental Control Board.

By repealing and reordaining, with amendments

Article 1 - Mayor, City Council, and Municipal Agencies Section(s) 40-2

Baltimore City Code (Edition 2000)

**Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore**, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

### **Baltimore City Code**

### Article 1. Mayor, City Council, and Municipal Agencies

#### Subtitle 40. Environmental Control Board

#### § 40-2. Board established.

(a) In general.

The Environmental Control Board of Baltimore City is established as an independent agency of City Government.

- (b) Composition.
  - (1) The Board comprises [13] 15 members.
  - (2) [6] 7 are the following ex officio members, or their respective designees:
    - (i) the Commissioner of Health;
    - (ii) the Commissioner of Housing and Community Development;
    - (iii) the Police Commissioner;
    - (iv) the Fire Chief;
    - (v) the Director of Public Works; [and]
    - (vi) the Director of Transportation; and
    - (vii) a member of the City Council, to be appointed by the President of the City Council.
  - (3) [7] 8 members are appointed by the Mayor in accordance with Article IV, § 6 of the City Charter.
- (c) Qualifications of appointed members.

Of the members appointed under subsection (b)(3) of this section:

- (1) 2 members must be appointed from the general public; and
- (2) [5] 6 members must be appointed with at least 1 designated as having expertise in each of the following areas:
  - (i) real estate;
  - (ii) small business;

- (iii) [air or noise pollution] education;
- (iv) water pollution;
- (v) solid waste; and
- (vi) community advocacy.
- (d) Chair.

The Chair of the Board is appointed by the Mayor from among the members.

(e) Compensation.

The members appointed under subsection (b)(3) of this section:

- (1) are not entitled to compensation; but
- (2) are entitled to reimbursement for expenses incurred as provided in the Ordinance of Estimates.

**Section 2.** And be it further ordained, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

Section 3. And be it further ordained, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the date it is enacted.
