For the purpose of modifying the contract-expenditure threshold that requires approval of a Parking Authority contract by the Board of Estimates.

By repealing and reordaining, with amendments

Article 31 - Transit and Traffic Section 13-4(h) Baltimore City Code (Edition 2000)

Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Baltimore City Code

Article 31. Transit and Traffic

Subtitle 13. Baltimore City Parking Authority

§ 13-4. General powers.

- (h) Contracts.
 - (1) The [authority] Authority may enter into contracts necessary or convenient to the exercise of its powers.
 - (2) The Authority's contracts are not subject to Article VI, § 11 of the City Charter.
 - (3) However, any contract involving an expenditure of [\$10,000] \$25,000 or more is subject to the approval of the Board of Estimates.
- **Section 2.** And be it further ordained, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.
- Section 3. And be it further ordained, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date it is enacted.
