**Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore,** That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

**Baltimore City Code**

**Article 31. Transit and Traffic**

**Subtitle 13. Baltimore City Parking Authority**

**§ 13-4. General powers.**

(h) *Contracts.*

- (1) The [authority] Authority may enter into contracts necessary or convenient to the exercise of its powers.
- (2) The Authority's contracts are not subject to Article VI, § 11 of the City Charter.
- (3) However, any contract involving an expenditure of [\$10,000] \$25,000 or more is subject to the approval of the Board of Estimates.

**Section 2. And be it further ordained,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

**Section 3. And be it further ordained,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the date it is enacted.
