By repealing and reordaining, with amendments

Article 4 - Community Relations Section(s) 1-1(i) Baltimore City Code (Edition 2000)

**Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore**, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

### **Baltimore City Code**

### **Article 4. Community Relations**

#### **Subtitle 1. Definitions**

### § 1-1. Definitions.

- (i) Employer.
  - (1) "Employer" means every person, other than fraternal and religious organizations, who employs [15] 1 or more persons, exclusive of parents, spouse, or children of [such] that person, during at least 15 days in the preceding 12 months.
  - (2) "Employer" includes any governmental unit, agency, or employer as to which the City has the power to legislate.

**Section 2.** And be it further ordained, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

Section 3. And be it further ordained, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the date it is enacted.
