## City of Baltimore Council Bill

An Ordinance concerning  
**Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation - Baltimore City Information and Technology Department - \$10,000,000**

For the purpose of providing a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation in the amount of \$10,000,000 to the Baltimore City Information and Technology Department - Service 805 (Enterprise IT Delivery Services), to provide funding for the City's ransomware response and recovery; and providing for a special effective date.

**Recitals**

The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from the Assigned Fund Balance in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2019.

This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2019 was formulated.

This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2019 was formulated or is for a new program that could not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.

On June 26, 2019, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City Council.

**Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore,** That \$10,000,000 shall be made available to the Baltimore City Information and Technology Department - Service 805 (Enterprise IT Delivery Services) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2019, to provide funding for the City's ransomware response and recovery. The source of revenue for this appropriation is funds from the Assigned Fund Balance in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2019.

**Section 2. And be it further ordained,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
