### Department of General Services Update on Sanitizing City-Owned Buildings

For the purpose of requesting that the Department of General Services provide the City Council with an update

on how employees of DGS have been keeping City-owned buildings clean during the COVID-19 pandemic and post information about cleaning schedules in these buildings.

### **Recitals**

**Whereas**, Baltimore City residents and employees are in danger of getting very ill or dying from COVID-19;

**Whereas**, One way to prevent the spread of the virus is to frequently sanitize areas used by the general public as well as work spaces;

**Whereas**, The Department of General Services (“DGS”) provides custodial staff and building security services for City-owned buildings; and

**Whereas**, The City Council is interested in learning how often DGS employees are cleaning City-owned buildings, what cleaning agents DGS employees are using to clean the buildings, and what, if any, other changes DGS has made to keep City-owned buildings safe for the public and for City employees.

**Now, therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of Baltimore**, That the City Council requests the Department of General Services provide the City Council with an update on how employees of DGS have been keeping City-owned buildings clean during the COVID-19 pandemic and post information about cleaning schedules in those buildings.

**And be it further resolved**, That a copy of this Resolution be sent to the Mayor, the Director of the Department of General Services, and the Mayor’s Legislative Liaison to the City Council.
