By adding

Article 6 - Historical and Architectural Preservation
Section 18A-1, to be under the new subtitle "Subtitle 18A. Landmark List: Exteriors 2020s"
Baltimore City Code
(Edition 2000)

Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Baltimore City Code

Article 6. Historical and Architectural Preservation

Subtitle 18A. Landmark List: Exteriors - 2020s

§ 18A-1. Reed Calloway House.

Reed Calloway House, 1316 North Carey Street.

Section 2. And be it further ordained, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

Section 3. And be it further ordained, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date it is enacted.
