### Recitals

**Whereas,** February is Career and Technical Education Month;

**Whereas,** Career and technical education is education that directly prepares high school students for successful careers;

**Whereas,** Career and technical education covers many different fields, such as health care, information technology, advanced manufacturing, hospitality, the arts, and business; and

**Whereas,** Many Baltimore City Public Schools offer career and technical education, allowing students to

access state-of-the-art labs, use professional equipment, learn from industry professionals, and experience internships in their chosen field.

**Now, therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of Baltimore,** That the City Council recognizes February as Career and Technical Education Month.

**And be it further resolved,** That a copy of this Resolution be sent to the Mayor, the CEO of the Baltimore City Public School System, and the Mayor's Legislative Liaison to the City Council.
