### An Ordinance concerning

For the purpose of defining the term "vacant building notice"; creating and amending certain penalties for failing to abate a vacant building notice; and generally related to the issuance and enforcement of vacant building notices.

#### By adding

Article - Building, Fire, and Related Codes Section 2-103 (IBC § 116.11) Baltimore City Revised Code (2020 Edition)

By repealing and reordaining, with amendments

Article 1 - Mayor, City Council, and Municipal Agencies Section 40-14(e)(5c) Baltimore City Code (Edition 2000)

Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

## Article - Building, Fire, and Related Codes

#### Part II. International Building Code

#### § 2-103 City Modifications.

The additions, deletions, amendments, and other modifications adopted by the City are as follows:

# Chapter 1 Scope and Administration

#### Section 116 Unsafe Structures

. . .

#### 116.11 Failure to abate a vacant building notice.

- **116.11.1 Definitions.** "Vacant building notice" means a violation notice issued under this section that designates a structure to be a vacant structure.
- **116.11.2** Citations. A citation for failing to abate a vacant building notice shall be issued at the discretion of the Building Official until the notice is abated.
- **116.11.3 Penalties.** Notwithstanding § 114 {"Violations"} of this Code, the penalty for each citation issued for failure to abate a vacant building notice is \$1,000.
- **116.11.4 Offenses.** Each day the vacant building notice is not abated is a separate offense.
