AN ORDINANCE concerning
Children, Youth, and Families

FOR the purpose of expanding the definition of "youth" for certain purposes; and generally relating to the Office of Children, Youth, and Families and the Baltimore City Youth Commission.

BY repealing and reordaining, with amendments

Article 1 - Mayor, City Council, and Municipal Agencies

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Baltimore City Code

Article 1. Mayor, City Council, and Municipal Agencies

Subtitle 22. Children, Youth, and Families

§ 22-1. Definitions.

(e) Youth.

"Youth" means an individual between the ages of 14 and [24] 25, inclusive.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date it

is enacted.
