A BILL ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE concerning  
**Charles Village Community Benefits Districts Management Authority - Council Representatives on Authority Board**

FOR the purpose of clarifying that the Councilmembers appointed to the Board of Directors of the Charles Village Community Benefits District Management Authority are voting members of the Board.

BY repealing and reordaining, with amendments  
Article 14 - Special Benefits Districts  
Section(s) 6-6(e)(2)  
Baltimore City Code  
(Edition 2000)

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Baltimore City Code

Article 14. Special Benefits Districts

Subtitle 6. Charles Village Community Benefits District

§ 66. Board of Directors.

(e) Minimum representation.

The following minimum representation shall be present on the full Board, except during periods of temporary vacancies:

....

(2) 2 VOTING members shall be members of the City Council appointed by the President of the City Council.  
....

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date it is enacted.

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
