CITY OF BALTIMORE COUNCIL BILL

A BILL ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE concerning

Environmental and Civil Citations - Burglar Alarm Registration

FOR the purpose of setting the amount of the fine collectable through environmental and civil citations for failure to pay a false alarm fee; clarifying, correcting, and conforming related provisions; and generally relating to environmental and civil citations for burglar alarm violations.

BY repealing and reordaining, with amendments Article 1 - Mayor, City Council, and Municipal Agencies Section(s) 40-14(e)(3) and 41-14(2) Baltimore City Code (Edition 2000)

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:
