# A Bill Entitled

An Ordinance concerning Baltimore City Landmark List: Exteriors - James D. Gross Recreation Center

For the purpose of designating the James D. Gross Recreation Center, 4600 Lanier Avenue, as an historical landmark: exterior.

By adding

Article 6 - Historical and Architectural Preservation Section(s) 17A-46 Baltimore City Code (Edition 2000)

**Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore**, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

# **Baltimore City Code**

## Article 6. Historical and Architectural Preservation

#### Subtitle 17A. Landmark List: Exteriors - 2010s

### § 17A-46. James D. Gross Recreation Center.

James D. Gross Recreation Center, 4600 Lanier Avenue.

Section 2. And be it further ordained, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

Section 3. And be it further ordained, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the date it is enacted.
