A Bill Entitled

An Ordinance concerning

Zoning - Conditional Use - Amending Ordinance 18-170

For the purpose of amending Ordinance 18-170, as enacted by Ordinance 14-206 and amended by Ordinance 16-469 and last amended by Ordinance 18-170, to reauthorize and continue the permission for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a parking lot for the parking of 4 or more automobiles on the property known as 4001 Roland Avenue; providing for the automatic termination of this Ordinance; and providing for a special effective date.

By repealing and reordaining, with amendments

Ordinance 18-170 Section(s) 2

Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Ordinance 18-170

Section 2. And be it further ordained, That the permission granted by this Ordinance applies through April 19, [2018] 2022; and, after that date with no further action by the Mayor and City Council, this permission will be abrogated and of no further effect.

Section 2. And be it further ordained, That this Ordinance takes effect when it is enacted.
