**Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore**, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

#### **Baltimore City Code**

#### Article 5. Finance, Property, and Procurement

#### **Subtitle 34. Commission on Sustainability**

#### § 34-2. Terms; Chair or Co-Chairs.

(b) Commission Chair or Co-Chairs.

The Mayor shall appoint one member as Chair of the Commission or may appoint two members as Co-Chairs of the Commission.

**Section 2.** And be it further ordained, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

**Section 3.** And be it further ordained, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the date it is enacted.
