**Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore,** That the unnamed alley, located in the rear of 216 East Biddle Street, between Hunter Street and Guilford Avenue, is named Mura Alley.

**Section 2. And be it further ordained,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the date it is enacted.
