## Recitals

Whereas, February is Career and Technical Education Month;

Whereas, Career and technical education is education that directly prepares high school students for successful careers;

Whereas, Career and technical education covers many different fields, such as health care, information technology, advanced manufacturing, hospitality, the arts, and business; and

Whereas, Many Baltimore City Public Schools offer career and technical education, allowing students to access state-of-the-art labs, use professional equipment, learn from industry professionals, and experience internships in their chosen field.

**Now, therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of Baltimore**, That the City Council recognizes February as Career and Technical Education Month.
