#### A Resolution Entitled

A Resolution of the Mayor and City Council concerning  
**Charter Amendment - Department of Real Estate**

For the purpose of establishing the Director of the Department of Real Estate as the head of Department of Real Estate; specifying that the Director shall be appointed by the Comptroller; making certain revisions; and submitting this amendment to the qualified voters of the City for adoption or rejection.

By proposing to amend

Article V - Comptroller  
Section 4  
Baltimore City Charter  
(1996 Edition)

**Section 1. Be it resolved by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore,** That the City Charter is proposed to be amended to read as follows:

#### **Baltimore City Charter**

#### **Article V. Comptroller**

#### **§ 4. Department of Real Estate - Established.**

There shall be a Department of Real Estate, the head of which shall be the [Comptroller] Director of the Department of Real Estate, who shall be appointed by the Comptroller.

For the conduct of the Department, the [Comptroller] Director shall appoint [a Real Estate Officer] real estate agents [and such assistants] and such employees as may be provided for in the Ordinance of Estimates.

**Section 2. And be it further resolved,** That this proposed amendment to the City Charter be submitted to the legal and qualified voters of Baltimore City, for adoption or rejection, in accordance with Article XI-A, § 5 of the Maryland Constitution, in the form specified by the City Solicitor.
