# City of Baltimore Council Bill

#### A Bill Entitled

An Ordinance concerning

#### Recordation and Transfer Taxes - Yield Excise Tax - Transactions Assessed

For the purpose of amending which transactions are assessed the Yield Tax; and providing for a special effective date.

By repealing and re-ordaining, with amendments

Article 28 - Taxes Section 17.1-2(a) Baltimore City Code (Edition 2000)

**Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore**, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

## **Baltimore City Code**

#### Article 28. Taxes

## Subtitle 17.1. Recordation and Transfer Taxes - Yield Excise Tax

#### § 17.1-2. Transactions assessed; Tax rate.

(a) Transactions assessed.

The Yield Tax shall be assessed on those transactions whose value exceeds [\$1 million] \$750,000.00, as determined by Subtitles 16 and 17 of this article for the purposes of calculating the recordation and transfer taxes respectively.

**Section 2.** And be it further ordained, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
