For the purpose of increasing a certain penalty on the operator of an establishment for knowingly permitting any minor to remain on the premises during certain curfews for minors.

**Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore,** That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

## Article 19. Police Ordinances

### Subtitle 34. Minors - Daytime and Nighttime Curfews

#### § 34-9. Penalties.

(b) *Operator of establishment.*

Any operator of an establishment and any agent or employee of any operator who violates any provision of § 34-6 {"Prohibited conduct of establishments"} of this subtitle is guilty of a misdemeanor and, on conviction, [is subject to a fine of not more than ~~\$500~~] shall be fined no less than \$1,000 for each violation.

**Section 2. And be it further ordained,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the date it is enacted.
