**Informational Hearing - Housing Authority of Baltimore City - Broadband Requirements and Access** For the purpose of inviting representatives from the Housing Authority of Baltimore City, the Department of Housing and Community Development, Baltimore City Information Technology, the Department of Recreation and Parks, and other interested parties to brief the City Council on the Housing Authority of Baltimore City's progress in furnishing broadband internet access to low-income City residents through the Federal Emergency Broadband Benefit program.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of Baltimore, That the City Council invites representatives from the Housing Authority of Baltimore City, the Department of Housing and Community Development, Baltimore City Information Technology, the Department of Recreation and Parks, and other interested parties to brief the City Council on the Housing Authority of Baltimore City's progress in furnishing broadband internet access to low-income City residents through the Federal Emergency Broadband Benefit program.
