Article 6 - Historical and Architectural Preservation Sections 18A-8 Baltimore City Code (Edition 2000)

Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Article 6. Historical and Architectural Preservation

Subtitle 18A. Landmark List: Exteriors - 2020s

§ 18A-8. 3110 Elm Avenue.

3110 Elm Avenue (Block 3504B, Lot 006).

Section 2. And be it further ordained, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date it is enacted.
